The exercise will be held on **Tuesday, December 4th from 11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. at the Albert Lea National Guard Armory, 410 Prospect Ave, Albert Lea, MN 56007**. Participants will engage in facilitated discussion with each other, key partners, and additional Subject Matter Experts during this three hour exercise. Lunch will be provided during the exercise.

- **Mission Areas:** Response and Recovery
- **Core Capabilities:** Public Information and Warning, Operational Coordination, Mass Care Services, Critical Transportation, and Health and Social Services.
